This book is an excellent companion to the *Hazmat Chemistry Study Guide*. The study guide goes into greater depth, and with hundreds of sample test questions, it's the best choice to help you succeed on the final exam. *The Hazmat Chemistry Mini Review*, on the other hand, provides a quick refresher that's great whether you're preparing for a test or reviewing the subject years later. (Note: Unlike the *Hazmat Chemistry Study Guide*, it does not cover the relation between hazmat chemistry and the DOT hazard classes.)

The Hazmat Chemistry Pocket Pal is also an excellent companion to the *Hazmat Chemistry Study Guide*.


Of the three hazmat chemistry books, this is the one most geared for field use. It stuffs a lot of content into a small format (6" tall x 3.25" wide), but still contains plenty of charts and graphics to enhance your understanding of chemistry and to provide a pleasing, easy-to-read format.

The Hazmat Chemistry Pocket Pal incorporates the content from the *Hazmat Chemistry Quick Reference Card* and *Comparing Three Primary Threats at a Hazmat Incident* (both shown on page 5), making this the best bargain for cost-conscious emergency responders. It also contains a Spill Estimation Chart developed by Kevin Smith, Deputy Fire Marshal-Hazardous Materials, Chino Valley Independent Fire District in California.

Like *The Hazmat Chemistry Mini Review*, this book emphasizes chemistry and does not cover the relation between hazmat chemistry and the DOT hazard classes.

Shipping Policy and Shipping Charges

Firebelle Productions no longer publishes shipping and handling charges because of the unpredictable price hikes in recent years. Instead, shipping charges are based on actual cost for shipping and packing materials.

I often ship small orders in U.S. Postal Service flat rate boxes, unless standard priority shipping is less expensive. I generally ship larger orders via UPS.

I can provide a ballpark estimate for customers who need it before placing an order. However, I don't have a handy rate chart. Rates vary based on how many books fit in each box, box sizes, weight, and the distance shipped.


